Met *Scriptura* 3 word die eerste eenheid van drie uitgawes voltooi. Onder die algemene tema van die Bybel en die kuns, lewer Reino Ottermann 'n bydrae oor die betekenis van godsdienstige musiek in verskillende vorme. C J Retief sluit aan by 'n artikel van H W Rossouw in *Scriptura* I en wys op die noue verband tussen Skrifinspirasie en teologiese hermeneutiek. In die afdeling vir eksegetiese studies lewer C W Burger 'n verdere bydrae met 'n analise van Ps 42/43 met spesifieke aanwysings vir die gebruik van hierdie gedeelte in die prediking. With the publication of *Scriptura* 3 the first unit of three issues of this new journal has been completed. Encouraged by the reaction of our readers, the Editorial Committee has decided to move from an experimental phase to a more permanent arrangement. We hope to expand our circle of contributors in the near future to include as many as possible universities and other educational institutions. The journal has also been introduced to a wider audience and will forthwith be abstracted by *New Testament Abstracts*.

In this issue, J W V van Huyssteen writes about the nature of faith and statements of faith. John de Gruchy, a well-known Bonhoeffer expert, throws new light on Bonhoeffer's use of his English Bible. Continuing *Scriptura*'s interest in the Bible and the arts, Reino Ottermann focuses on the role of music in devotional life. C J Retief's article on inspiration and theological hermeneutics is a reaction to Rossouw's contribution in our first issue. In his homiletical contribution, C W Burger this time analyses Psalm 42/43 with pertinent suggestions for the preacher. A very important issue regarding the future of Biblical Studies and Scripture in our educational system is discussed by H J S Stone. In our guide to recent literature,
